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POLICY FOR ADMINISTERING LONG ACTING INJECTABLES

Alexandra Linardakis RN will offer the service of administering long acting injectable anti-psychotic medication. Once a collaborative relationship with a MD is established, then the patient or a caregiver can schedule an appointment for the administration of the medication. The patient comes to their appointment with an order from one of the psychiatrists that she has a collaborative relationship with as well as the prescribed medication.

Alexandra will carry her own malpractice insurance for this service. The prescribers will have the medication prescription available electronically under the patient's privacy protected chart for Alexandra to check the medication against before administering.

There will be regular consultation on the shared patients a monthly rounds that Alexandra establishes with the prescribers.

Patient ability to verbalize the reason for the medication and whether or not it has been effective will be assessed and documented once a month.

Patient openness to education about side effects will be assessed, discussed and documented once a month. Openness to interventions to take precautions about more common side effects to be assessed, discussed and offered then documented.

Supportive resources utilized as well as needed will be assessed and documented.
